



**Board Meeting Public Comment Q&A
September 26, 2018**

- 1. Who is responsible for the maintenance of the crosswalks in front of the schools? There is not a crosswalk on El Diente and 93rd and the other crosswalk on 93rd is faded.**
 - A. The Streets, Sidewalks and Crosswalks within Candelas are being transitioned over to the City of Arvada. The remaining sections, which include the Three Creeks School, are currently in the final phase of transition. The two crosswalks in question will be addressed prior to the transition to the City of Arvada.

- 2. Who is responsible for the lights within Candelas? It is Dark around the curve of 93rd Drive and Candelas Parkway.**
 - A. The street lights that are installed within Candelas are designed to comply with the City of Arvada's night sky ordinances. The City has reviewed and approved the location of all street lights within the community. The Street Lights within Candelas will ultimately be the responsibility of the City of Arvada as each phase is transitioned. This particular section of lighting in Filing 1 is in the process of undergoing repairs by the District. We expect the transfer of lights in Filing 1 to the City of Arvada to be completed by year end.

- 3. There are no Stop Signs on McIntyre in the Direction of Candelas Parkway. This is believed to be a Safety Concern.**
 - A. The City of Arvada is responsible for all Street Signage. The District's recommendation would be to reach out to the City of Arvada with a request for additional signage. You may reach them at Arvada Community Development 720.898.7435.
